

#### **Pond Tips**

- Transplant/divide aquatic plants
- Begin fertilizing
- aquatic plants Add nitrifying bacteria to
- biofilter and/or pond water
- Switch to high protein fish foods as waters warm
- Move tropicals into pond when water approaches 70 degrees

# Garden & Birding Tips • Fertilize spring-blooming

- perennials
- Replace mulch around plants
- Plant annuals after danger of frost is past
- Begin planting container perennials, shrubs
- Offer nesting materials for birds
- Set up hummingbird feeders
- Stop feeding suet; offer soft foods for nesters
- Clean feeders

### **Pond Tips**

- Add tropical water lilies after temperature above 70,
- tropical nightbloomers added once temperature stabilizes at 75 degrees.
- Divide irises after bloom is finished
- Monitor water quality for ammonia and nitrite
- Remove dying vegetation and spent blooms

#### Garden & Birding Tips

- Apply compost to garden
  Deadhead blooming flowers to maintain nectar supply for butterflies and hummingbirds
- Prune spring-flowering shrubs when bloom completed
- Plant new ground covers and perennials
- Mulch, mulch, mulch
- Continue offering nesting materials & soft foods
- Clean feeders
