OUR POND

Water Gardening, Ducks and Geese!

Late always enjoyed gardening indoors and out, and although I am strictly an amateur, I go about my work with the same fervor as a professional. Over the years I have enjoyed my hobby in pots, in the ground, in baskets, in terrariums, as bonsai, and even in large shells which I made into miniature landscapes. However, the most rewarding and totally engrossing (obsessing?) hobby by far is water gardening.

A friend introduced me to this fascinating hobby a few years ago when I visited one summer afternoon and became totally enchanted with her in ground pool, fish, and plants. I asked questions galore, enjoyed watching the fish as though hypnotized, and came home with samples of her various plants. Another friend, I soon discovered, was also into water gardening, so my path was set with yet another source of free water plants!

We have 2 nice sized dirt ponds; one with an island which I had dug several years ago for my Giant Dewlap Toulouse geese, Canada geese and black swans. Living on 329 mountain acres, my water source is a spring high on a hill, sup-

plying gravity-flow water 24 hours a day, 365 days a year, which empties into the pond in a fountain spray. My 'goose hoose' is a pole building construction, rather over-kill constructionwise. It is south facing, has a metal roof to ease in shedding winter snow, and has a six-foot-high chain link enclosure. Because of predators, I lock all my waterfowl in the hoose at night.

I enjoyed raising my breeding stock from goslings and they quickly bonded with me. They have personal names—my first pairs of swans were Mr. and Mrs. Swanson and Mr. and Mrs. Swenson. The Dewlap trio were named Louis Toulouse, Lucille Toulouse and Tulip Toulouse. They multiplied so quickly that my imagination gave way for identification after the first few! I had two pair of Canada geese, Gregory and Gabby (a very talkative lady) and Tag and Little Bit who hatched Gander last year. Guyser was a visitor who stayed. I have had a pair of wild Canadas visit yearly, as well as a pair of Mallard ducks which raised their young on the pond two years in a row.

My water gardening began with a whiskey barrel. When the fish and plants met an early demise in the unlined containers, I graduated to barrel liners and soon was not content with just two barrels. Last year I placed a lotus in a barrel on one level of my porch and then a step down to

the large barrel with water lily, plants, and fish. Quite dramatic. Like every gardener knows, the need for 'more' is always a nagging force. I purchased a 100-gallon Rubbermaid stock tank with a drain and used that as a dividing wall in my garden. A problem occurred when the drainplug failed and I found my fish flopping in about one inch of water and my plants high and dry.

I do not filter or aerate my barrel gardens. I do plant rather heavily and use Enviro-reps International's 'Super Bugs' bacteria-enzymes to balance my water. I have a degree of sidewall algae, but it is controlled. The barrels are drained and cleaned once a year. Enjoyment of movement is from the goldfish and mosquito fish. My two ponds were hatchery, nursery and home to some 40 goldfish of various sizes and thousands of mosquito fish until a blue heron visited this winter.

With our El Nino weather patterns of last winter, I left two barrels intact outside and every once in a while saw my goldfish swimming lazily around.

I tried growing water lilies in cages made of fivefoot-high fencing in the goose pond, but they still made very tasty and expensive banquets for my waterfowl. Iris from my gardens do well and water lettuce, duckweed and parrot's feather multiply rapidly and give some degree of cover to the fish.

I believe the grossest thing I ever experienced was finding one of my goldfish dead and dried on the lawn outside my big barrel. It puzzled me. Several days later I happened to be walking by the barrel when something orange in the grass caught my attention. There was a water racer snake trying to devour one of my big goldfish...sideways! I happened to have a hammer in my hand and with a tap, the snake retreated under my porch. I picked up the fish, dropped it back into the barrel, and went about my way.

When I dismantle my gardens for winter, I put most of the plants in barrel liners and tubs in the laundry room. I had a calla lily blooming in there in March. When I brought the fish and plants inside, I enjoyed them so much that I now keep a large plastic 45-gallon tub inside year-round for my butterfly koi and fantail goldfish.
